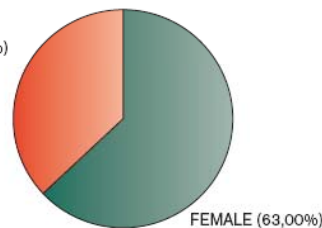


5.1.2 Evolution of the activity 2003-2007

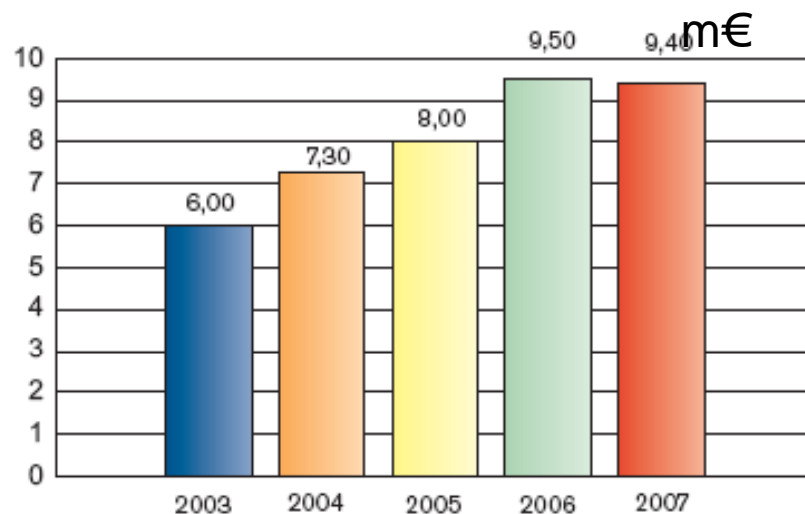

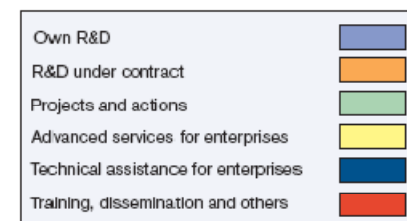
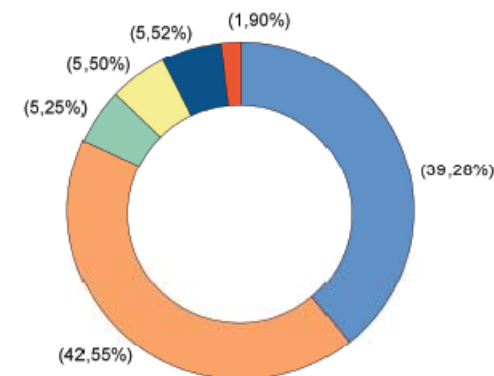
